COUNSELING

- for victims of criminal offenses, their relatives and social environment, witnesses, as well as professionals who come into contact with victims
- relief discussions, psychoeducation and stabilization after traumatic experiences
- help to return to normality through structuring everyday life
- teaching techniques for support in coping with the consequences of the crime
- mobilizing the resources of those affected and their support systems
- information on filing charges and the criminal proceedings
- information on support and compensation options (victim funds, foundations, etc.)
- advice on decision-making (filing charges, relocation, therapy, etc.)
- referral to suitable specialist services and network partners

Counseling takes place independently of reporting to the police.

SUPPORT

Accompanying witnesses / Confidant according to § 406f para. 2 StPO

- information about procedures, rights and responsibilities of injured parties and witnesses in criminal proceedings
- stabilization and relief in relation to the criminal proceedings and the questioning of witnesses
- referral to lawyers and/or relevant specialist services of the police
- accompaniment to police hearings, public prosecutor's office or court
- follow-up of the criminal proceedings

Psychosocial support in criminal trials in accordance with § 406g para. 3 StPO

- certified form of support for witnesses through the criminal proceedings
- especially for children, adolescents and particularly vulnerable adults as injured parties in cases of serious violence and/or sexual offenses
- as well as for injured persons and survivors in the case of homicides
- possibility of being appointed by the court after application

The content of the witness statement is not discussed.
